Assessment

The NEBOSH Certificate in Fire Safety course includes two assessments:

- **FSC1:** An online, open-book examination to be completed within 24 hours.
- **FSC2:** A practical fire risk assessment to be conducted in the candidate's workplace, utilizing frameworks and standards like the Home Office fire guidance and PAS79-1:2020. While there is no time limit for this assessment, three hours are recommended to create a thorough risk assessment. NEBOSH external examiners will evaluate both parts of the assessment.
